



TRAP DISCIPLINE UPDATE - HOURS, FEES & SHELLS

The Board of Directors has consistently stated the Club's commitment to the sport of Trap and recognizes the potential for Trap to be a valuable discipline at RRG.

Beginning Sunday March 27, 2022, the Trap range will be open for shooting and under new direction. Brad Cohen and Terry Gibson, Board members, will manage the Trap facility on an interim basis until a permanent Director is located.

There are subjects that need to be addressed in an effort to contain and correct unfounded discussions regarding Trap, as well as to start to develop the potential we feel exists.

- Through the month of March 2022, all trap coupons will be accepted under the current practice.
- Beginning Sunday, April 3, 2022, the green coupon book that was purchased for \$40 per book (10 coupons per book) will have a \$4 single coupon value that can be used toward a round of trap. The yellow coupon book that was purchased for \$50 per book (10 coupons per book) will have a \$5 single coupon value that can be used toward a round of trap. The appropriate balance for the cost of a round will be paid at the time of shooting. This will be valid thru September 2022, after which time no coupon(s) will be accepted. No cash exchange will be honored for a coupon.
- Beginning Sunday, April 3, 2022, the price for a round of trap will be \$7 (the same price as a round of 5-stand). This price is based on the cost of clays and the other costs attributed to the operation of trap. Youth and military fees will be \$6 per round. Non-members will be charged the \$6 range access fees as at all disciplines, plus the cost of clays.
- Beginning Sunday, April 3, 2022, hours on trap shoot days will be 10:00am to 2:00pm.

- **Beginning Sunday, March 27, 2022, Trap shooters will be able to purchase shot gun shells at the posted price – subject to availability. The policy for purchasing shells will be one round of trap allows the purchase of one box of shells. Shells may not be purchased to take off premises.**

These subjects have been given serious time and consideration based on the facts of operation of RRGC. The BOD wants all disciplines to be successful individually and be a joint benefit to the Club. This must be our objective to be the best Club that we can be. Please, if you haven't shot at Trap lately, come out and do so, enjoy the sport, support the club and meet the new faces in the house.

We still are searching for the new Director of Trap. If you have interest or know of someone that does and will be a positive addition for RRGC, make contact with any BOD member.
